CSCN EEG Examination Time-Based Eligibility Criteria

Available only for the 2025 examination

Shall be a physician certified as a specialist in:

- a) Neurology (adult or paediatric)

- b) Another specialty acceptable to the examination board, with a minimum of six months of training in neurology

AND

Complete a minimum of six months of full-time formal EEG training within a two year period. For example, training fragmented into multiple 1-2 month rotations spread over 3-4 years is NOT acceptable.

Training shall be completed in EEG laboratories that perform a minimum of 1,500 EEGs annually for a wide variety of adult and pediatric patients.

Provide written evidence from the training director of satisfactory completion of training by the candidate.

Note:

If an applicant has not yet completed the required number of weeks of training by the time of their application, then the program director should submit the Confirmation of Training form indicating the applicant's anticipated dates of training. Applicants may be provisionally accepted on the basis of training in progress, however their program director will be recontacted one month prior to the date of the examination to verify that training has been successfully completed as documented on the Confirmation of Training form. If training has not been successfully completed by one month prior to the examination, then the application will be deferred to the following year.
